


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
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IN THE NEWS!

WALK TALL

Encourage your loved one to:

- Walk upright and straight to promote better posture
- Be more active, this can help to keep a straight and upright posture
- Start slowly when becoming physically active to avoid a sudden drop in blood pressure
- Notice when pain is preventing activity and report it to nursing staff

MOBILITY AIDS:

- Encourage proper use of walkers and/or canes
- Encourage walking in the center of the walker
- Ask nursing staff or the physiotherapist if the height of the assistive device is correct. The wrong height can cause poor balance, poor posture and shoulder pain
- Keep room and hallways clear of any objects and clutter. This way mobility aids can be used freely and prevent stumbling.
- Notify a staff member if you notice their assistive device (cane or walker) is not in proper working condition. Canes should have intact rubber tips.
- When walking with someone using a cane or walker, let them walk at their own pace. Never try and make them walk faster. Do not push someone sitting on their walker.

DROP-OFF LOCATION FOR RESIDENT CLOTHING



Families and friends are reminded to bring all new incoming clothing items for residents, to our centralized drop off cabinet for labeling.

The cabinet is located in the Main Hall outside the General Store and is equipped with bags and methods of identifying to whom the new items belong. We appreciate your attention to this matter.

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
