

We hope the following information will be useful to you and your family as you prepare for, or deal with, the loss of a loved one. Our thoughts are with you during this difficult, emotional time.

Grieving

Losing a loved one is a stressful event. It takes time to heal and adjust to changes that come with that loss. Be kind to yourself and those around you through this difficult time.

Everyone experiences grief differently – some feel shocked, sad, angry, scared, or anxious. Some feel numb or have a hard time feeling emotions at all. Many people feel relief or peace after a loss. You will grieve in your own way and in your own time, but you don't need to do it alone.

Ask for help from friends, family, neighbours and co-workers. They want to support you, but often don't know what you need. People can feel shy talking about emotions; they may think you want to be alone. If you need a coffee date or someone's shoulder to cry on – tell them.

If you have challenges in your own health, or personal relationships, that can make your loss more difficult. We encourage you to get extra help and support to work through your grief and get your life back in balance.

There are support groups and services at local community centres. There are professionals who specialize in grief counselling and faith leaders who can guide you.

Some tips to help you move through your grief:

- » Find healthy ways to share your feelings and express yourself, such as talking with friends or writing in a journal.
- » Plan ahead for holidays and other important days that may feel hard.
- Take good care of your body
 speak with your doctor if your grief is affecting your health.
- » Wait before making major life decisions. Change can add to the stress you're already experiencing.

Moving away

FROM CASSELLHOLME

Cassellholme strives to be supportive and responsive to the needs of grieving family and friends. At the same time, our caring staff has a responsibility to the many people waiting for placement in Long-Term Care. It's an awkward balance.

We must require, therefore, that your loved one's belongings be removed from the room within 24 hours of passing, or relocating.





W H A T T O P A C K

We understand that a sudden move can be challenging. Some items can be left behind, as they are always needed by other Residents:

- » tea cups
- » one bag of gently used clothing
- » large print books
- » iPods, iPads, Kindles, etc.
- » record albums, vinyl, LP's, 45's
- » portable air conditioners [8,000 12,000 BTU]
- » televisions
- » scrapbooking supplies

All other items must be removed. If you would like to use one of Cassellholme's carts for moving your Resident's belongings, please ask any member of our staff.

On page 11, you'll find a list of other North Bay locations who accept various donations.

CLOSING YOUR ACCOUNT

If there is a credit on the account, Cassell-holme will mail you a cheque, along with a final statement.

Cassellholme does not do automatic withdrawals for the final payment, as Resident accounts are only billed to the last day of occupancy and thus not a set amount. If there is a balance owing, we ask that you bring in or mail a cheque. You can apply trust money to the final rent owing.

If accommodation fees were paid from the Resident's/family account, the bank will freeze the account. That's why we ask you bring a bank draft or cash to avoid the frozen account returning an NSF cheque.

- □ your ID driver's license/health card


