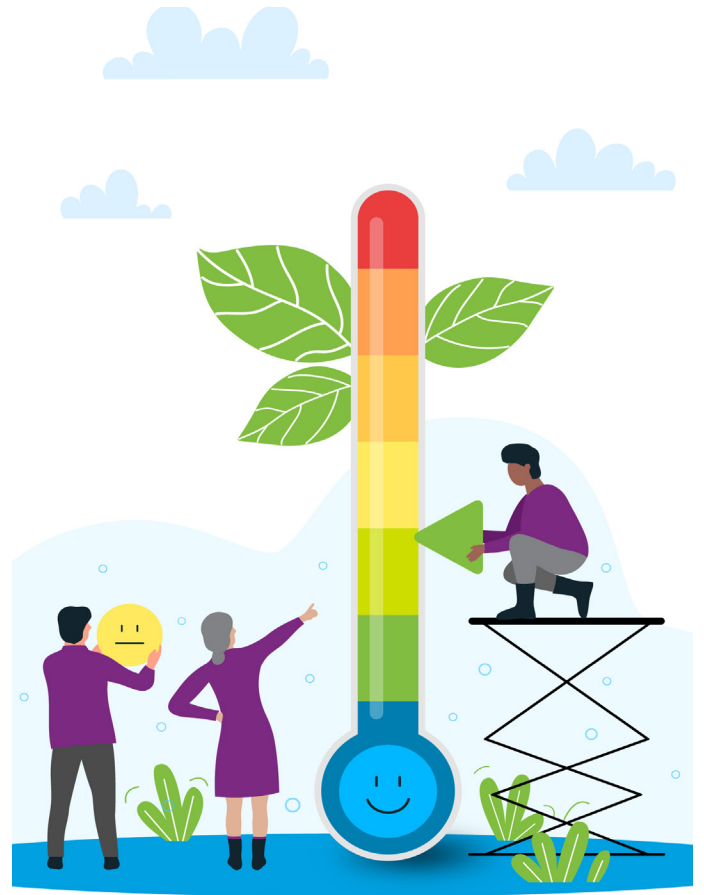
Keeping our Residents healthy and comfortable in the warm months is a high priority.

Ontario Regulations 246/22 (regulation) under the Fixing Long-Term Care Act, 2021 requires homes to ensure that air conditioning is installed, operational, and in good working order in every Resident bedroom during the period from May 15 to September 15 each year. Cassellholme has sought an exception from the Ministry of Long-Term Care as the current electrical system cannot support air conditioning in certain rooms.

Clear policy and procedures help staff know what actions must be taken immediately. All Resident rooms without air conditioning have a real-time temperature monitoring system.

Once our redevelopment is finished, ALL Resident rooms will have air conditioning.

Meanwhile, we have personal air conditioning units available, if room temperatures can't be maintained between 22°C and 26°C in the summer. Additionally, all cooling equipment in common areas, including hallways, lounges and break rooms were replaced and/or upgraded between 2019 and 2022.
